### **1. Bus Strikes**

Bus services in the city are currently being disrupted due to industrial action and I am aware that this will make travel to school more difficult for some pupils.

### **5. Year 6 Places**

Earlier this month, families found out which secondary school their child will attend in September. I am aware that many families were disappointed not to gain a place at Ark St Alban's. There were nearly 600 applications for just 120 places.
