

Remote Learning Overview

There are three different reasons pupils may need to complete remote learning:

- In the event of full or partial school closure
- In the event of their year group or form group needing to isolate
- In the event of an individual pupil needing to self-isolate

All year groups:

Each day will follow the same structure:

- Heads of year will email pupils at 8.30am in the morning outlining the timetable and deadlines for the day.
- Pupils will need to complete their work using Microsoft Teams on the laptops provided to them or using their own device.
- Pupils must submit their assignments by 2.00pm each day. To ensure that the deadline is met, pupils should work through sessions in the order set out on the timetable.

After the 2.00pm deadline pupils can continue with the afternoon lessons and revision. Parents can support your child's learning by checking the timetable, checking assignments have been submitted and looking at quiz scores on Wednesday morning.

Each morning, pupils will be provided with six lessons to complete and it is expected that it will take them a full school day to complete them. These lessons will include a mixture of videos, PowerPoints and workbooks. Pupils will be assessed *at least* twice each week for each subject either through an online quiz or an extended assignment task which their teachers will review.

Each afternoon, if a pupil has not completed their set assignments parents will receive a phone call from the school to let them know and discuss any support that may be required.

All students engaging with the remote learning are agreeing to comply with the updated Code of Conduct that can be found [here](#).

Years 11 & 13

From Monday 11th January Y11 and Y13 will also receive live lessons as part of their provision through MS Teams. More information on how to access live lessons will be communicated with students on Thursday and the website will be updated.

For pupils in other year groups more information about the provision of live learning opportunities will be shared in the weeks ahead.
